## A Word from our HOA President

With summer approaching, I encourage everyone to take a close look at the pool sign-up information in this newsletter. The price of our pool memberships has not increased, and Newington continues to be the best community pool bargain in Summerville. We are expecting a fantastic 2022 pool season!

Annual Newington Plantation Estates Association dues are still only \$100 (that's right only \$100 per year!). Your Association appreciates all the Newington property owners who

have fully paid their 2022 HOA dues, and we are very pleased with Newington's exceptional payment compliance rate. For those few who have not yet paid your HOA dues, I urge you to pay them right away to avoid accumulating additional late fees or facing collection costs. As a reminder, HOA dues are mandatory for all Newington homeowners (except for those homeowners in the patio homes). At past NPEA meetings, there has been considerable interest in the idea of adding a community clubhouse next to our pool. This new building could serve as a meeting location for Newington homeowners and as a recreation center for Newington families. It could bring people together as a place for parties, receptions, club meetings, and other social gatherings. Thom Nolan is serving as the Board's point-of-contact for the Newington clubhouse project. Our first step is to is to hire an engineer to evaluate our options and to examine the project's feasibility. We need to know if there are any flood plain issues or engineering constraints that may significantly impact the project. At the next NPEA Meeting, the Board will ask members to approve an expenditure of up \$10,000 to hire an engineering firm that would give us a feasibility report and to provide us with preliminary planning options. If it is done right, a Newington community center could improve the quality of life here, as well as increase our home values.

The Board of Directors will ask homeowners at the April NPEA Meeting to approve changes to NPEA's bylaws. These include:

**Change 1.** At the end of Article II, Section 5, add the following:

"NPEA bank checks will be signed by the President, or the Treasurer, or a Board-approved financial manager. The signatures of two of these people are required on any check written for \$2,000 or more. The Treasurer shall review a list of all NPEA checks, withdrawals, and deposits made each month."

Change 2. Make Article III, Section 5. Read: "Whenever a Board member is unable to perform his duties by virtue of transfer, health, conflict of interest, or other cause, such member should submit his resignation in writing to the Board citing the reason. If the position of President becomes vacant, then the Vice-President immediately becomes the President. If there are any other vacancies in the Board by reason of death, resignation, a failure to fill a position during a NPEA election, or otherwise, such vacancies shall be filled by a majority vote of the Board of Directors then in office. Individuals selected to fill vacancies serve for the remaining balance of that Board's term of office."

**Change 3.** Make Article III, Section 6 read: "The Board of Directors shall have power to manage and control the affairs of the Association, including the authorization of all expenditures provided, however, any action taken by the Board of Directors with respect to any Association expenditure (other than common, recurring operating expenses, or legal expenses, or expenses necessary to repair an existing NPEA asset) of more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) must be pursuant to the direction of a majority of the membership in attendance at a prior general membership meeting."

I plan to post a final agenda on <a href="www.npeasc.com">www.npeasc.com</a> several weeks before our next homeowners meeting. The meeting will start right at 7:00 pm, on Monday, April 25, at the Newington School Cafeteria. I hope to see you there!

New and returning swimmers who are interested in joining the team should plan to sign up at the Newington pool on one of these dates:


